

# SENER Issues the Amendment to the Second Call for the Priority Processing of Applications for Electricity Generation Permits and Interconnection to the SEN

On May 11, 2026, the Ministry of Energy (“**SENER**”) published in the Official Gazette of the Federation (the “**DOF**”) the “*Second Call for the Priority Processing of Applications for Electricity Generation Permits and Interconnection to the National Electric System, Aligned with Binding Planning*” (the “**Second Call**”), whose objectives, scope, and specifications can be viewed [here](#).

In light of the foregoing, on May 26, 2026, SENER published in the DOF the “*Agreement Issuing the Amendment to the Second Call for Priority Processing of Applications for Electricity Generation Permits and Interconnection to the National Electric System, in Line with Binding Planning*” (the “**Amendment to the Second Call**”).

Below is an executive summary of the most relevant aspects of the Amendment to the Second Call:

### A. Updated Timeline for the Second Call

The Amendment to the Second Call establishes a specific timeline for each stage of the procedure, including the registration of expressions of interest, the submission of permit applications, the resolution of objections, the issuance of interconnection study results, the acceptance of Interconnection Works and Reinforcement Works, and the issuance of permits by the CNE, as follows:

Dates	Stages	General Description
May 13 – 29	Period for expressions of interest and requests for interconnection studies.	Submission of the registration of expression of interest and request for interconnection studies through the VUPE.
June 1 – 4	Requirements by CENACE.	Review of the request for interconnection studies and, if applicable, address the requirements made by CENACE.
June 5 – 8	Determination of payments for interconnection studies.	Notification by CENACE of the amounts to be paid for studies or revalidation of previous studies.
June 9 – 15	Payment for interconnection studies.	Evidence of payment made for interconnection studies.
June 16 - July 15	Submission of the application for an electricity generation permit.	Formal submission of the application for an electricity generation permit to the CNE through the OPE.
July 16 – 20	Review of requirements and notification of conditions by the CNE.	Review and verification of submitted documents and information, and issuance of conditions by the CNE.
July 21 – 24	Addressing the requirements notified by the CNE.	Submission of supplementary information and documentation to address the requirements of the CNE.
July 27	Notification of costs for Reinforcement Works and Interconnection Works.	Communication of study results and costs of Interconnection and Reinforcement Works by CENACE.
July 28 – August 4	Express acceptance of the costs of Interconnection Works and Reinforcement Works.	Express acceptance of the costs and works determined by CENACE using the Works Acceptance Form.
August 5 - 11	Reevaluation of results for Interconnection Works and Reinforcement Works.	Exceptional reevaluation of the results of the studies and costs of the works due to withdrawals or other adjustments.
August 12 – 13	Express acceptance of the cost of the redefined Interconnection Works and Reinforcement Works.	Express and irrevocable confirmation of the costs and works determined by CENACE through the Works Acceptance Form.

Dates	Stages	General Description
August 14 – 19	Evaluation of technical studies and binding planning criteria.	Technical evaluation of the projects in accordance with the binding planning criteria.
August 20 – 21	Review and approval of permits by the CNE Technical Committee.	Review and, where applicable, approval of permits by the CNE Technical Committee.
August 24	Publication of the results of the Second Call.	Official publication of the results of the Second Call.
August 25	Notification of permits approved under the Second Call.	Notification via the OPE of permits granted to the applicants.
